









# DEGREE APPRENTICESHIP APPLICATION PROCESS





1. CV/online
application
Submitted directly
to the employer



3. Test or in-tray exercise

This could be before or during the interview



5. Interview

This could be either online or in person



2. Telephone interview

Used by employers to filter initial applications



4. Assessment centre

Held at the employer's offices or sometimes at the University

### APPLYING FOR MANCHESTER MET





Step 1: Register

Receive direct alerts by entering your details at

mmu.ac.uk/study/apprenticeships



Step 2: Look

Visit our website and employer websites

Peak vacancy time: November - April



**Step 3: Apply** 

Processes vary but usually involve a CV and cover letter or online application form. You may also have to attend an assessment centre and/or interview

### **APPLYING FOR MANCHESTER MET**





#### **Step 4: Success**

Congratulations! You've got the job. You'll sign a contract with your new employer setting out the terms of the apprenticeship



#### **Step 5: Application**

Complete your university application directly with Manchester Met and enrol onto your course. This usually takes place a few months before you start



### Step 6: Begin

Apprenticeships usually start with an induction week, where you'll get an introduction to the course and meet other apprentices


