Following the recent end-of-term assessment, your child has been identified as someone who we believe would benefit from some additional support in Mathematics. Over the next two weeks, we will be running lunchtime sessions (1:15-1:45) for the pupils to provide them with an opportunity to do some follow-up work on the content of the test. The first session will be on Wednesday $1^{\text {st }}$ December in IT4 and the second the following Wednesday $\left(8^{\text {th }}\right)$. We would then like them to complete a short re-test in order to give them an opportunity to confirm their understanding of the topics we have covered. The retest will take place on Wednesday $15^{\text {th }}$ December and will focus on the main skills from the end-of-term assessment. To get the best out of the session it would be useful for pupils to have a pair of headphones with a standard 3.5 mm jack.

In addition to attending the lunchtime sessions, in order to correctly prepare for the retest, we would also encourage students to use their 'Review Sheet' and the video solutions of the end-of-term assessment, which they can watch to help them understand how and where they lost marks in the assessment. Alongside the video solutions, they can also use the revision worksheets emailed to them prior to the original test. We would appreciate any support and encouragement you can offer so that your child can really improve their understanding during this process.
