Jewellery in school

I am writing to you to remind you of school's expectations surrounding the wearing of jewellery. Whilst the vast majority of year 10 students follow the rules in this regard, there have been a few occasions where form tutors and I have had to speak with students about their jewellery and/or piercings.

As such, I wish to remind you of the rules set out in the parents' handbook, which states:

Students may wear one pair of gold or silver studs, or sleepers in the ear lobe only. No other piercings are permitted. If a student arrives at school with a piercing that is not allowed, they will be expected to remove it.

Rings, bracelets, necklaces and other jewellery items are not allowed.

Failure to remove this jewellery will result in working away from classes until the item is removed.

In the first instance, we shall be confiscating jewellery, which can then be collected at the end of the day. For repeated incidents, parents/carers will be asked to collect jewellery from school.

Please ensure that you remind your child of the above rules if they have a tendency to wear jewellery in- or outside of school.
