 - Writing some summary notes on a topic where subject knowledge was lacking.
 - Completing some similar calculations to the one(s) which went wrong.
 - Writing out quotes or key facts which you should incorporate into your answer next time.

Students are expected to bring their fully completed pack of questions into form on Monday 11th March.
