Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you about the upcoming **End of Year Mathematics Assessment** taking place for all Year 8 students. They have been set the following instruction on Satchel One, alongside the necessary topic list. We ask for your encouragement to ensure thorough preparation from your child.

“Your End of Year Maths Assessment will take place during the week commencing May 19th (exact date TBC) in your maths lessons. The test will be non-calculator.

You must ensure that you have a pen, pencil and ruler.

Please refer to the attached topic list to see exactly what you will be tested on. It references Dr Frost Maths key skills numbers that are relevant for each chapter, and we would advise that you use DFM to supplement your revision. The school’s Schemes of Work are on DFM, so you are able to search specifically for questions on this via ‘Courses’ at the top.

The link to the whole year’s revision worksheets is also attached. You will need to just pick the worksheets that match with your revision list, rather than do all of them. Each worksheet has three sections of increasing difficulty, ‘support’ and ‘core’ and a ‘depth’, for you to attempt depending on your confidence of that topic. There is no expectation for you to do every single topic, but we do expect you to prepare thoroughly for the assessment. Your class teacher will also provide you with some revision materials, but these should not be the only revision you complete.

You may also find it beneficial to use/re-attempt your previously completed unit assessments as useful revision tools to help you to familiarise yourself with exam style questions.
If you have any issues, please speak to your class teacher.”
