Last term our students attended a combined total of 2,189 individual clubs across the areas mentioned above. Last term, we also launched our bronze, silver and gold extra-curricular awards where students are awarded with the levels based on their engagement in the clubs across the arts; performing arts; sports and fitness; STEM; community and hobbies and culture. It was great to see 260 students achieving a bronze award, 165 students achieving a silver award and 9 students achieving a gold award. We want our students to continue to attend the broad range of extra-curricular clubs on offer to help keep developing their overall character and experiences beyond the curriculum that is offered. During this term, we will complete our second round of bronze, silver and gold extra-curricular awards.
