RE: Year 9 GCSE RS Visit to Manchester Central Mosque – June 2026

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As you are aware, your child is studying aspects of both Islam and Christianity as part of their GCSE Religious Studies course. They are currently undertaking units on Islam covering topics on beliefs and practices of Islam. A major aspect of this unit is to study the Muslim place of worship identifying the main features of a mosque as well as other roles a mosque serves in the Muslim community. Therefore, they will have the opportunity to gain information and insight in an authentic setting by participation in the visit to the **Manchester Central Mosque** in Manchester in June/July 2026.

Trips will take place on 29th, 30th June and 1st July. You will be notified of the specific date your child will go on the trip nearer the time.

The coach will leave school at 10.00 a.m. and arrive back at the school by 2.00 p.m.

All pupils will be required to wear full school uniform and respect the mosque dress code by dressing modestly (trousers or knee length skirts).

We would also like to take advantage of the Mosques location and take your child to enjoy some cultural cuisine often enjoyed in Islamic countries by dining in a nearby restaurant, My Lahore, after their visit to the mosque.

Your child will have the choice of 3 different dining options:
