- Ensure all responses are fully anonymous, so you can share your views openly and honestly.

Parent and Carer Survey

During the week beginning Monday 9th March, I will send you a link to complete our Parent and Carer Survey. The survey will take around 15 minutes to complete. We are aiming for a response rate of at least 70%, as this will ensure the feedback is representative and statistically meaningful.

Student Survey

In the coming weeks, students will complete the survey during an extended form time session in one of our IT suites. All students will be encouraged to take part, but participation is voluntary and any student may choose not to complete the survey.
