I am writing to inform you about the upcoming **End of Year Mathematics Assessment** taking place for all Year 7 students. They have been set the following instruction on Satchel One, alongside the necessary topic list. We ask for your encouragement to ensure thorough preparation from your child.

“Your End of Year Maths Assessment will take place in your exam week (commencing 11th May – exact date TBC) in your maths lessons. The test will be **non-calculator**. You must ensure that you have a **pen, pencil, ruler and protractor**. Please refer to the attached **topic list** to see exactly what you will be tested on.

Revision tips:

- There is no expectation for you to do every single topic, but we do expect you to prepare thoroughly for the assessment. Some topics may need more attention than others.
- DFM key skills numbers are matched with each topic on the topic list.
- Your class teacher will also provide you with some revision materials, but these should not be the only revision you complete.
- The link to the whole year’s revision worksheets is attached to this satchel post. Choose your level of difficulty from ‘support’, ‘core’ and a ‘depth’.
- You can also re-attempt specific questions from your previously completed unit assessments to focus on areas highlighted from your review sheets and familiarise yourself with exam style questions.
- You can find other revision tips on your topic list and attached to your scheme of work overview sheet.
