Dear Parents/Carers,

In Key Stage 3, each year group will have an end of year assessment week in most of their subjects during the summer term. The Year 8 end of year assessment week will take place between Monday 18th and Friday 22nd May (Week B). However, the RE assessments will take place during Monday 11th to Thursday 14th May. The subject assessments will focus on what students have been taught since the start of the academic year and build on knowledge students have learnt since the start of Year 7. Each assessment will be around 40 minutes long. Students should ensure they have the correct equipment with them each day for the assessments, as well as their reading book.

The assessments will take place during the students' lessons in each subject and within their class groups. It is important students are aware of their class code for each subject and can be found on their timetable and Satchel One. An overview of each class's subject assessment days can be seen below, however more information will be provided via the students' satchel one accounts for each subject.

Students' teachers will inform them of how best to prepare for the assessment, however this year a focus of the school has been to help develop students' independent revision skills. I have also attached a handout about the strategies we are encouraging students to use to help them to prepare for assessments.
