



## Urmston Grammar School

Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a fantastic first week back at Urmston Grammar School after the Easter holidays and we have been so impressed with the way our students have started the summer term.

So far, this academic year our students have attended 3,356 individual clubs across activities in the arts; performing arts; sports and fitness; STEM; community/hobbies and culture clubs to help develop students' overall character development in our below chosen traits. At this present time, we have 207 students who have achieved a bronze extra-curricular reward, 210 students who have achieved silver and 54 students who have achieved a gold award. This is based on how many clubs students have attended across the six extra-curricular areas. We will continue to monitor the students' progress in extra-curricular engagement and certificates will be awarded in the final summer term assemblies.

This really does show that students at Urmston Grammar School are more than the sum of their grades. We want our students to keep attending the broad range of extra-curricular clubs on offer to help further develop their overall character and experiences beyond the curriculum that is offered; thus, continuing to follow our school values of Pride, Participation and Empathy.
