### Year 10 Trip to Alton Towers – Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026

The cost of the trip will be £37.00, and this includes coach hire and entry into Alton Towers. **The pupils will need to be in school early, for 7.45am, the coaches will be departing at 8.00 am and we will not return to school until approximately 7.30pm.**

They will need to make their own way home. They will need to bring provisions for their lunch and drinks throughout the day. We would also remind you that no responsibility can be taken for personal items by staff.

Students will also receive a full briefing in school ahead of the trip, including behaviour expectations and what to bring.

By making payment you agree to Urmston Grammar School's Trip Payment Agreement. There is no charge for students who qualify for Pupil Premium funding. Please also complete the consent form, emergency contact and medical information on Parent Pay.

Pupils not attending the trip will be expected to attend school as usual and will be working, under supervised conditions, in the LRC.

We are very proud of our Year 10 students and look forward to celebrating their achievements with a fun and memorable day out.
