



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OPPORTUNITIES

[Drone Pilot](#)

A drone pilot (UAV operator) remotely flies unmanned aircraft for commercial services like aerial photography, surveying, and inspections. They work in varied industries, often as freelancers, and must possess [CAA training and certifications](#). Professional pilots plan flights, monitor equipment, and manage safety.

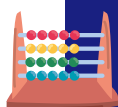
