URMSTON GRAMMAR OPEN EVENING 2026 – STUDENT PARTICIPATION

We are delighted to inform you that our annual Open Evening event will take place on **Wednesday 17th June from 4:00pm to 8:00pm**. Every year, we look forward to welcoming students currently in Year 5 and their parents and carers, as they begin to make decisions about their secondary education. It is always an incredibly popular event and is a key date in our school calendar. Our students play a key role over the course of the evening and are always wonderful ambassadors for our school.

We have divided the evening into two distinct sessions.

- Session one will run from 4pm until 6pm and will involve **ALL** students in Year 7 and 8 and forms U/R/M/ in Year 12.
- Session two will run from 6pm until 8pm and will involve for **ALL** students in Year 9 and 10 and forms S/T/N/G/X in Year 12.
