



Urmston Grammar School Remote Learning Contingency Timetable

Though the start to the 2021-22 Academic Year has been very smooth, the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic still presents the potential for significant disruption to children's education. The following document outlines how Urmston Grammar School intend to continue teaching students if there is a period of partial or full lockdown during this school year.

Remote Learning Timetable

In the event that whole cohorts or the entire school return to home learning for a period of lockdown, all students will follow their typical timetable of lessons just like they follow in school. This means they will remain in the same groups with their usual teachers.

As the nature of remote learning is inherently more challenging than face to face learning in the classroom, some small amendments will be in place compared to usual routines.

- (1) All lessons will be 45 minutes rather than 1 hour. This will reduce screen fatigue and allow students and teachers additional time to prepare between lessons. The amended timings of each lesson will be as follows:

- (2) The majority of lessons will be live streamed through MS Teams, however some lessons may be pre-recorded or may consist solely of tasks students to complete independently. This will be at the discretion of each teacher.

During the course of any period of lockdown students and parents will be surveyed to gain feedback on the remote learning experience so areas for development can be identified and improved.

Instructions for remote learning will be communicated to students via their school email accounts or Show My Homework.

If students encounter additional personal challenges during lockdown, their initial point of contact should be their form tutor or pastoral leader.
