As before this list contains books for students of all ages, but because the subject matter of some great books can also be difficult to process for younger readers, you will find some books have been marked as appropriate for students of Years 7 upwards, while others are suggested for year 10 upwards only. If you are in any doubt, students can discuss with their teachers whether a book is suitable and we would always recommend that parents take an interest in what their children are reading and assess suitability where appropriate too.
