

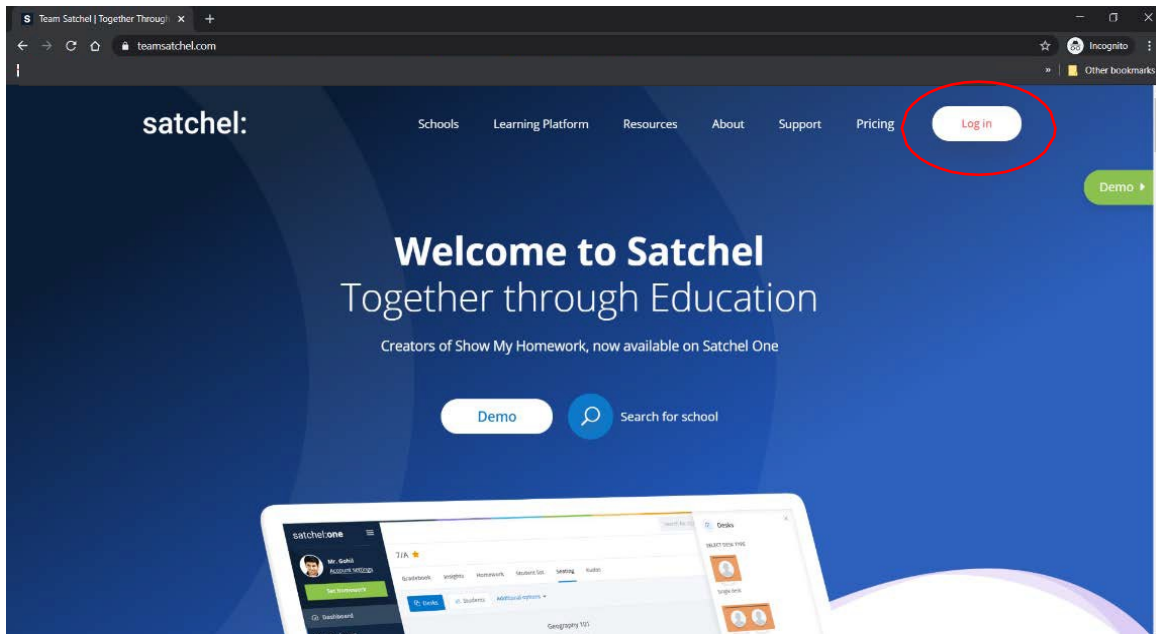

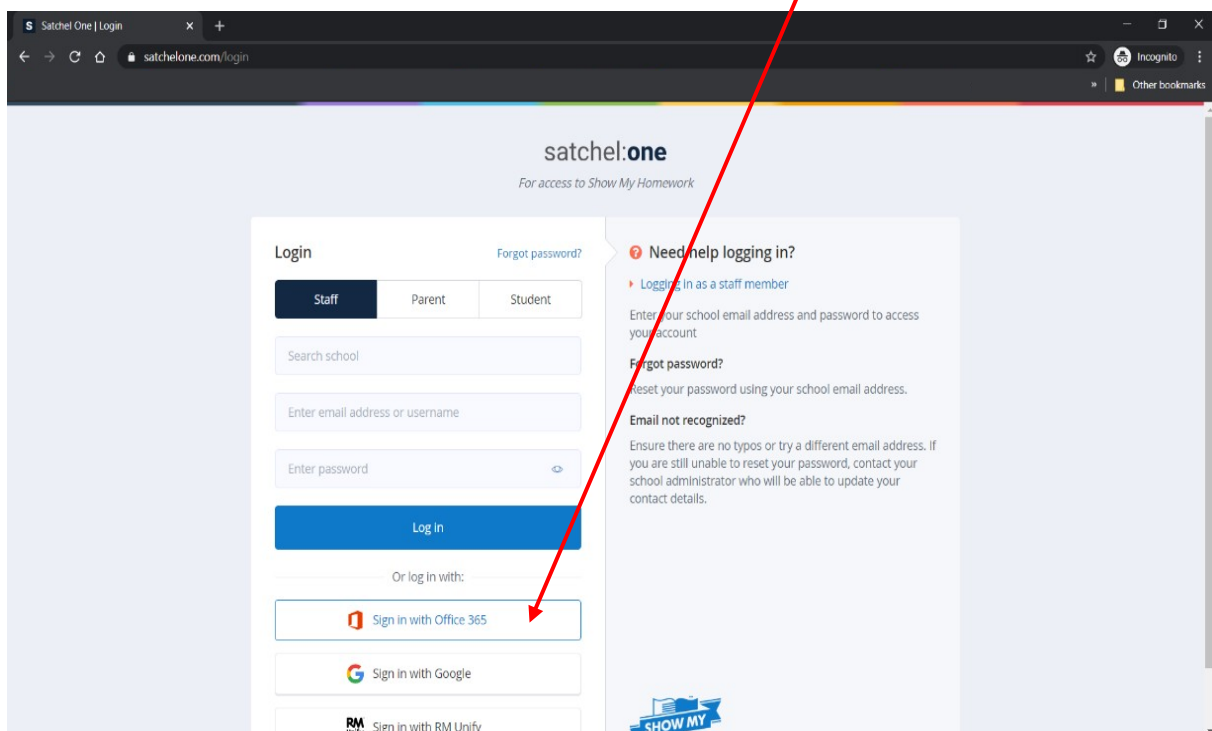


## HOW TO LOG ON TO SHOW MY HOMEWORK

**Step 2:** **DO NOT** click on Log in – instead, click on **Sign in with Office 365**

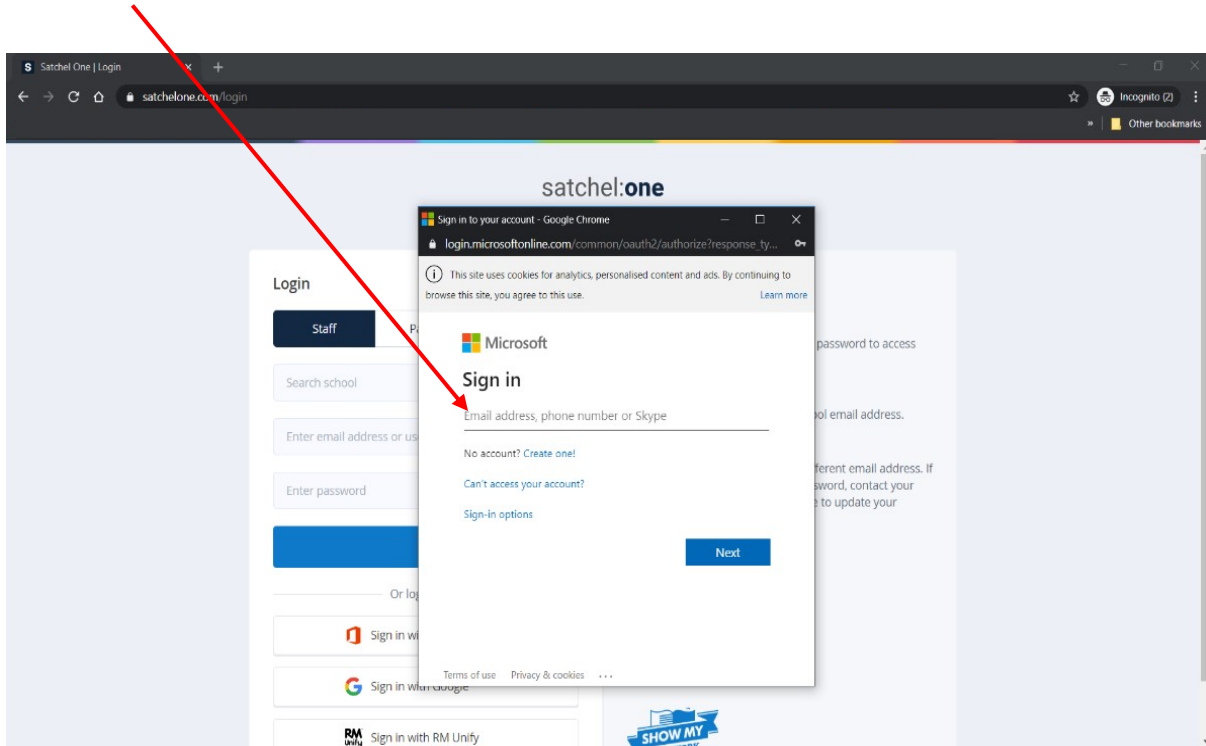




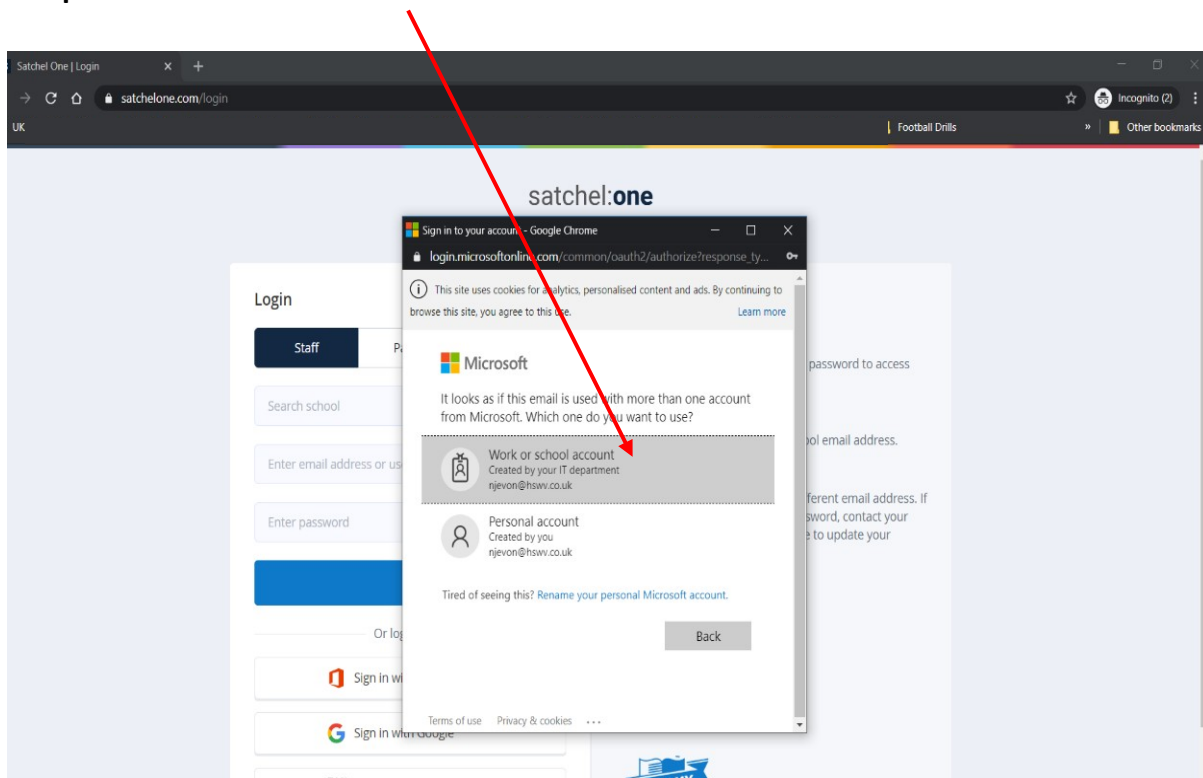

**Step 4:** Click on Work or School Account

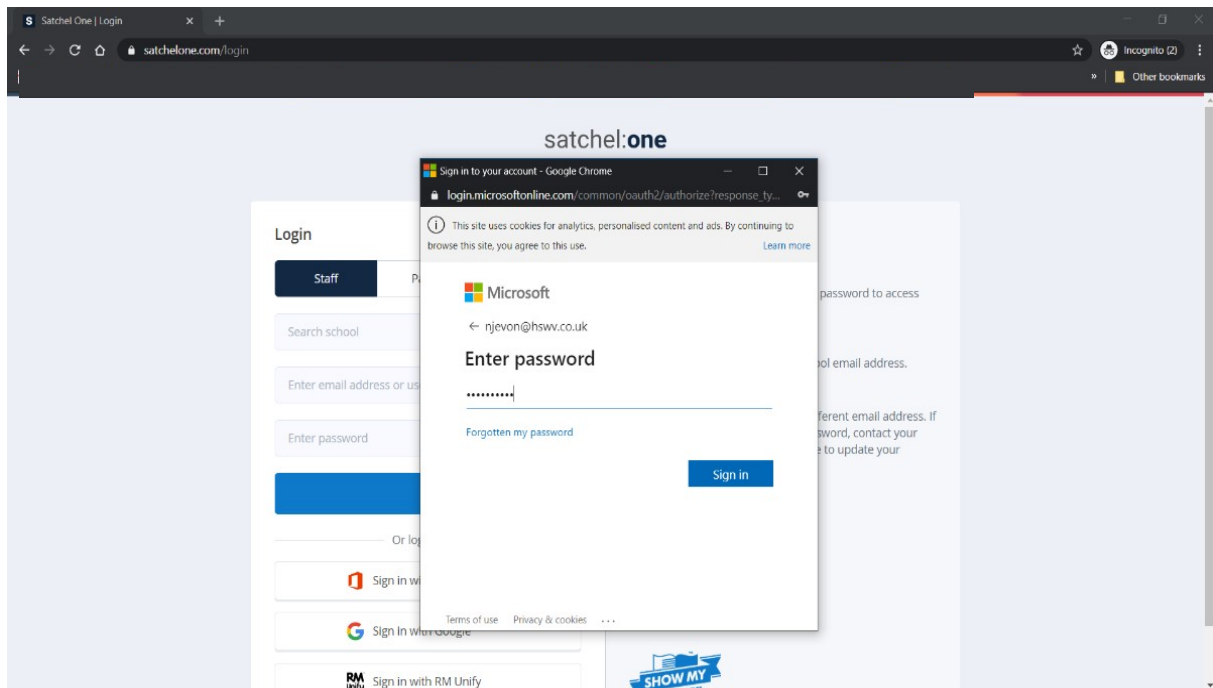




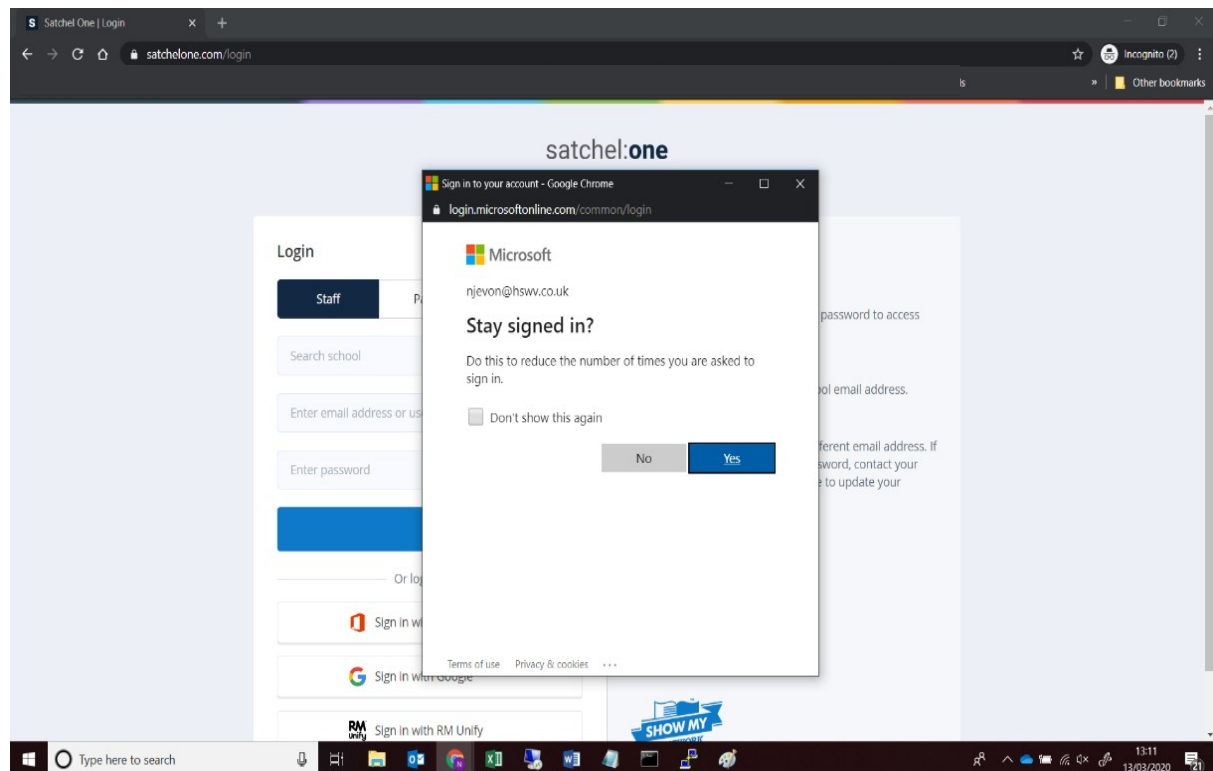
