Dear Parents & Carers

In week two of the Easter holidays the Geography Department will be running two days of extra teaching and learning for Year 11. Students will work with their class teacher, in their usual classroom.

**Day 1 – Wednesday April 12<sup>th</sup>** we will deliver a day of lessons looking at Paper 3, students will complete questions and teachers will go through responses and model answers.

**Day 2 – Thursday April 13<sup>th</sup>** we will use periods 1 & 2 to revisit fieldwork, the rest of the day will be for independent revision, past paper practice, folder organisation and an opportunity to seek clarification on topics.

The offer is not compulsory, although students who under performed in their mock exam would be wise to attend. In order to plan effectively and ensure student safety we need parents to give consent using Parentpay by March 14<sup>th</sup> please.

We will also be conducting a Year 13 practice paper and exam workshop on the second day so it is vital that Year 11 students attending are conscientious and prepared to use the time purposefully. All of our usual behavior expectations will apply, however students can come in their own clothes and can bring snacks / lunch with them. Students are, unusually, allowed off site during their lunch hour, and so could purchase lunch in Urmston (there will be no canteen facilities in school).

Students will need to sign in and out at the main entrance, most of school will be shut and maintenance work is being carried out in a number of areas (since it is the Easter Holidays) so students will need to stay within the Geography area for the duration of their time in school, unless they are also attending a session run by another department on the same day.
