RE: History GCSE intervention and support

I would like to inform you about an Easter Holiday revision morning that the history department is going to hold in school. The revision sessions will take place on April 14th and will cover all four topics that the students have studied in years 10 and 11. Most of the session will be taken up with exam technique but there will be some content revision.

The morning will start in the theatre at 9.30am and I will take the students through the Weimar and Nazi Germany paper. The theatre fire escape doors will be open from 9.15am and students should enter the building at that point.

At 10.30am students will go into their classrooms to cover the rest of the course on rotation. Each session will last 50 minutes with a 10 minute break in between each one:

I envisage the sessions finishing at around 1.30pm. Students will be dismissed from the sports hall entrance.
