Dear Year 9 Parents and Carers,

The week beginning **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June** will be the Summer Assessment Week for Year 9. This is an important time as it gives students the opportunity to demonstrate progress and learning during Key Stage 3 at Urmston Grammar School. The outcomes of these assessments will serve to inform students where their areas of strength lie so these can be celebrated. They will also be useful to identify areas for development so students can seek to improve as they embark on their GCSE subjects in September.

Further information regarding the assessment week is as follows:

- Year 9 students will sit test papers in English, Maths, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, History, Geography, Religious Studies and either French or German. These will take place in classrooms during timetabled lessons.
- Please find attached the timetable for the assessment week which informs students when the test will be in each subject. We have tried to ensure the assessments are reasonably spread across the week. Due to timetable restrictions, some assessments may be sat early the following week.
- Revision lists will be posted on ShowMyHomework shortly. We encourage you to support your son/daughter in conducting suitable preparation for their assessments.
- Students will not sit formal tests in Art, Computer Science, D&T, Drama, Food, Music or PE, however other formats of summative assessment will be conducted during the summer term in lessons.
- All results will be reported back to parents/carers in the tracking report later in the summer term.

Any student who is not sure of their class code for a subject can check on the ShowMyHomework app, or confirm this with their teachers.
