Index cards are a fantastic way to reinforce learning and identify strengths and weaknesses in a wide variety of subjects

- 1. Writing the cards helps to consolidate knowledge and focus on the key learning needed from each lesson.
- 2. Once produced, they can be used by students to test themselves, or perhaps be tested by parents or carers.
- 3. Adding traffic lights means students can see their strengths and weaknesses, knowing which cards will need more attention in the future. This allows future revision to be focused where it is needed most.
- 4. This could be trialled in one subject area. Making one or two index cards after each lesson to cover new content. By the end of the year, you have a bank of resources
