Paris Trip: June 2024

I am pleased to inform you that we are in the process of planning a French trip to Paris for next year's Year 8, which will take place in June 2024 (currently $10^{th} - 14^{th}$ June).

This is a trip that the school has run in the past, though not for a few years, due to Covid-19. It will be available to those students studying French in the current year 7 (forms U, R and T) who will therefore be in 8U, R and T next academic year.

Unfortunately, due to the maximum amount of time travel providers can hold bookings without payment, and the impending summer holiday being longer than this maximum hold time, I am unable to confirm all of the details at this stage. Nevertheless, I wanted to give you some advance notice that the trip will be running and to provide you with some initial information to give you an idea of how I hope the trip will look:

- Travel will be via coach (and ferry) from Manchester to Paris.
- Accommodation will be in a hotel that caters specifically for school groups in the outskirts of Paris.
- Breakfast and evening meals will be provided (except for meals en route).
- There will be a range of visits/activities, including where possible: a tour of the Stade de France, a boat trip on the River Seine which will take in views of many of the most famous sites of Paris include Notre-Dame Cathedral and the Eiffel Tower, a trip up Montparnasse tower for panoramic views of the city, a walk through Montmartre, and a day at Parc Astérix (a theme park).
- The overall price will be confirmed in September, but we anticipate that an initial deposit of around £100 per student will be required to secure a place on the trip, payable early next academic year.

As soon as the prices are confirmed in September, I shall send a letter with more precise details as well as how to sign up for the trip. This will hopefully be in the first few days of term.
