Re: Year 13 Re-sit exam - Chemistry

Dear Parents/Carers,

Recently, your child completed a re-sit exam in Chemistry after wanting to improve their Predicted University Grade (PUG) in the subject.

The exam itself was similar to that sat in the Summer Term; it covered aspects of course content from both of their teachers and was also a comparable difficulty. They were provided with a revision list that informed them of the topics to revise over the Summer.
