Dear Parent / Carer,



Further to my letter sent in July, I am pleased to outline below a visit to Munich for all students in years 10, 12 and 13 studying German, and who have worked and behaved well. The trip will leave on **Monday 5th February** and will return on **Thursday 8th February** (the exact times will be communicated nearer the time). We will stay in a hostel just west of the city centre. During the trip, we will visit Munich itself, take a trip to the *Olympiastadion*, the host stadium of the 1972 Summer Olympics, and enjoy a guided tour of *Neuschwanstein* castle, the inspiration for Walt Disney's Cinderella Castle. In addition, we will visit the BMW headquarters and have a guided tour of Dachau concentration camp. Students are expected to use their German as much as possible, and will have many opportunities to do so.

The cost will be £666 per student and includes return flights, all breakfasts and evening meals at the hotel, all entrance tickets, and insurance. The cost does **not** include food on the outward and return journeys, lunches in Germany or passport/visa costs.

Students applying **will need their own passport** valid till September 2024, and, if not UK citizens, any necessary visas. Students will also need their own UK Global Health Insurance Card (UK GHIC) for free medical treatment while in Germany. This card is free, and you can apply online at https://www.nhs.uk/using-the-nhs/healthcare-abroad/apply-for-a-free-uk-global-health-insurance-card-ghic/.

If your child is offered a place, we shall need an initial, **non-refundable** deposit of £150 via Parentpay. The remaining £516 can then be paid either as a lump sum or in 4 monthly instalments of £129 each. As we expect demand for the 33 places to be high, **places and reserve places will be allocated by drawing names**. If your child wishes to apply for a place in the draw, they **must** follow the instructions below. Failure to do so may result in your child's name not going into the draw.

Application instructions

Thursday 21st September	Hand in completed, signed form (attached) to Finance Office .
Friday 22 nd September	A list of names drawn from a hat will appear on the door of L5 (Languages Corridor).
Friday 22 ^{nd -} Wednesday 27 th September	If your child has been offered a place, you will need to pay the £150 deposit via Parentpay by 12 noon on Wednesday 27 th September. If no deposit has been received by this time, your child's offer of a place may be withdrawn.

Further information will be provided in due course, and a meeting for parents/carers and students will be held in January.

Please note that, should the work or conduct of any student allocated a place on the trip fall below acceptable standards, we reserve the right to withdraw that student's offer of a place.
