



Purpose of the trip

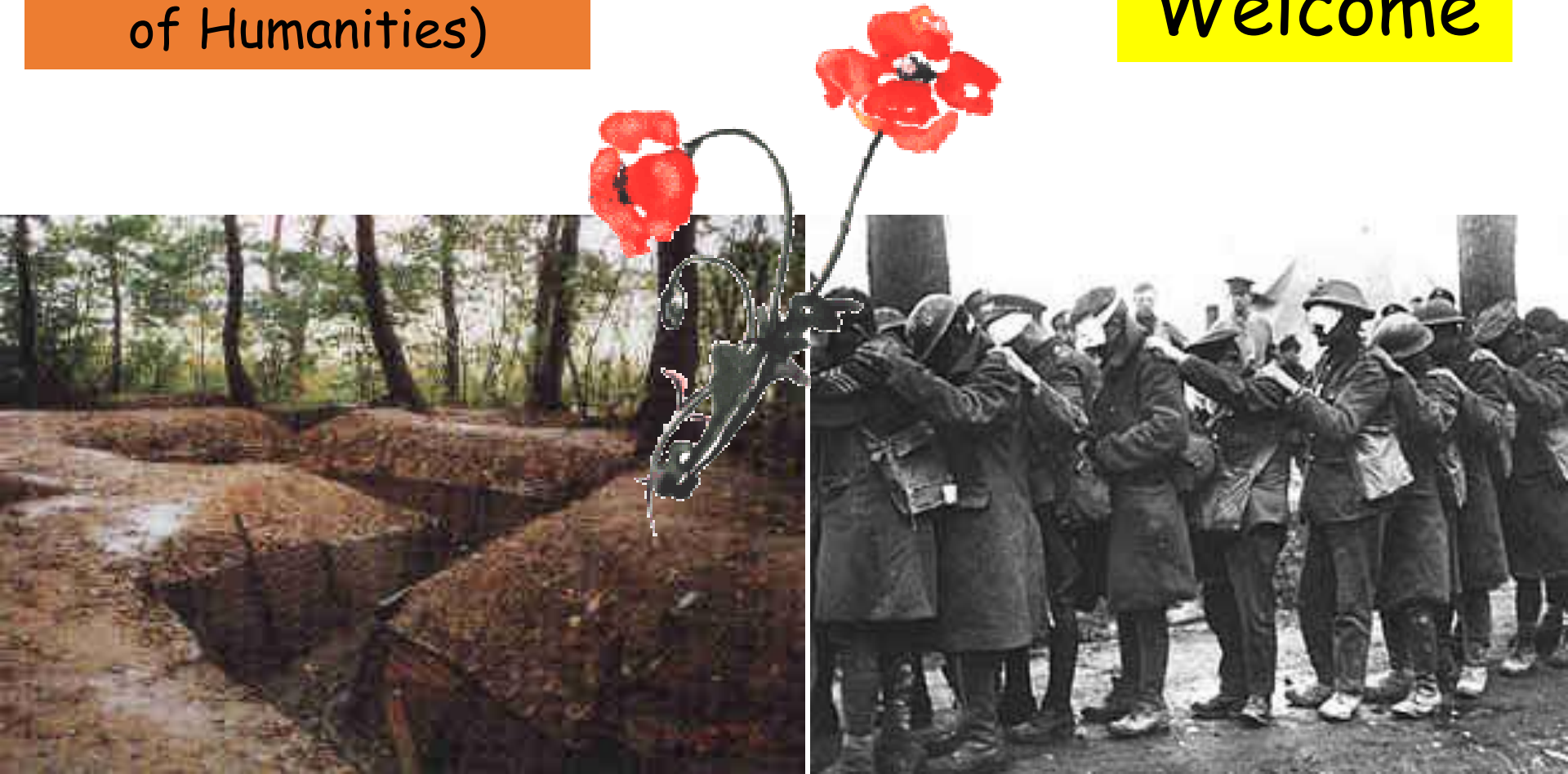
- To provide students who have an interest in history and in World War One the opportunity to visit the museums and memorials of the Somme and Ypres areas.
- To undertake some fieldwork study on life in the trenches and on two of the major battles of the war.
- To analyse how the dead and missing of the war have been remembered in France and Belgium
- To examine the archaeology of the war - the remains of the trenches, shell holes, craters etc
- To examine how the French and Belgian museums have interpreted the war and compare this to what students have learnt in class.
