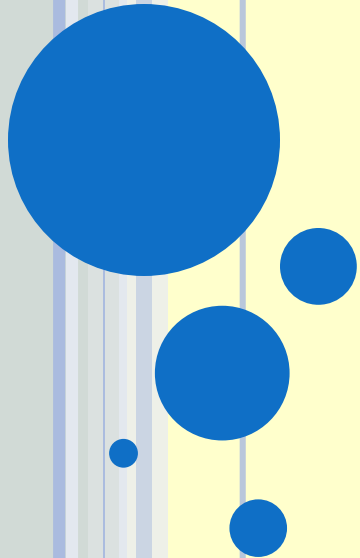

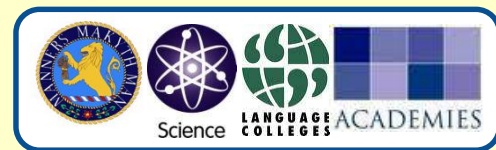

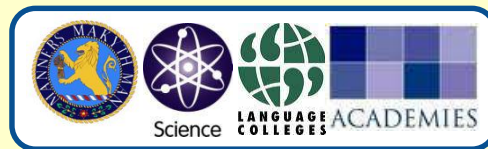

- You will need a Grade C in GCSE English and GCSE Mathematics.
- You need to have at least GCSE B in any subject that you want to continue to A level.
- If you wish to study A level Chemistry you will need to have one grade A in GCSE Sciences and Grade A in GCSE Mathematics.
- If you wish to study A level Mathematics you will need to have Grade A in GCSE Mathematics.

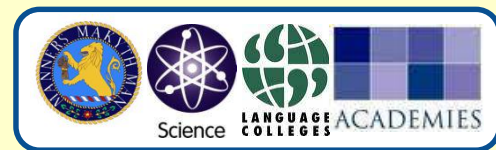

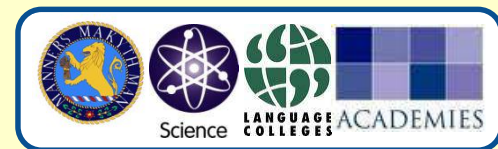

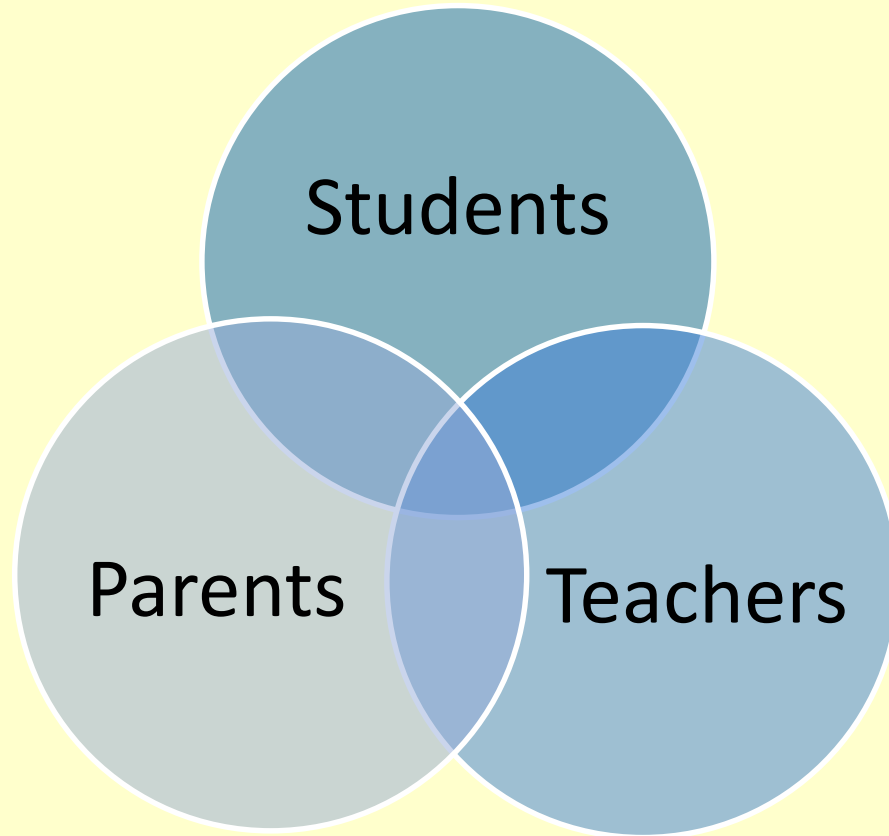
